The communication minor is designed to provide students with an understanding of the basic concepts of communication. There is one prerequisite course to the minor and the minor itself consists of four courses (12 credit hours). The prerequisite course and the four courses in the minor cover each of the following areas: communication theory, communication technology, interpersonal communication, mass communication, and strategic communication.

The prerequisite course and all four courses in the minor must be completed to satisfy the minor requirements.

If you complete the minor with the prerequisite course and the four courses specified below, you need only declare the minor with your college/school office. No approval from the School of Communication is required.

Communication minor program guidelines

<u>Credit hours required</u>: A minimum of 12. 1000 level courses shall not be counted in the minor. At least 6 credit hours must be upper-division courses (3000-level or above) as defined by the College of Arts and Sciences.

<u>Transfer and EM credit hours allowed</u>: A student is permitted to count up to 6 total hours of transfer credit and/or credit by examination.

Overlap with the GE: A student is permitted to overlap up to 6 credit hours between the GE and the minor.

Overlap with the major and additional minor(s)

- The minor must be in a different subject than the major.
- The minor must contain a minimum of 12 hours distinct from the major and/or additional minor(s).

Grades required

- Minimum C- for a course to be counted on the minor.
- Minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA for all minor coursework.
- Course work graded Pass/Non-Pass cannot count on the minor.
- No more than 3 credit hours of course work graded Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory may count toward the minor.

X193 credits: No more than 3 credit hours.

<u>Declaring the minor</u>: Students should see their assigned academic advisor to declare the minor prior to the filing of the graduation application. Students do not need the approval of the School of Communication to declare the minor.
